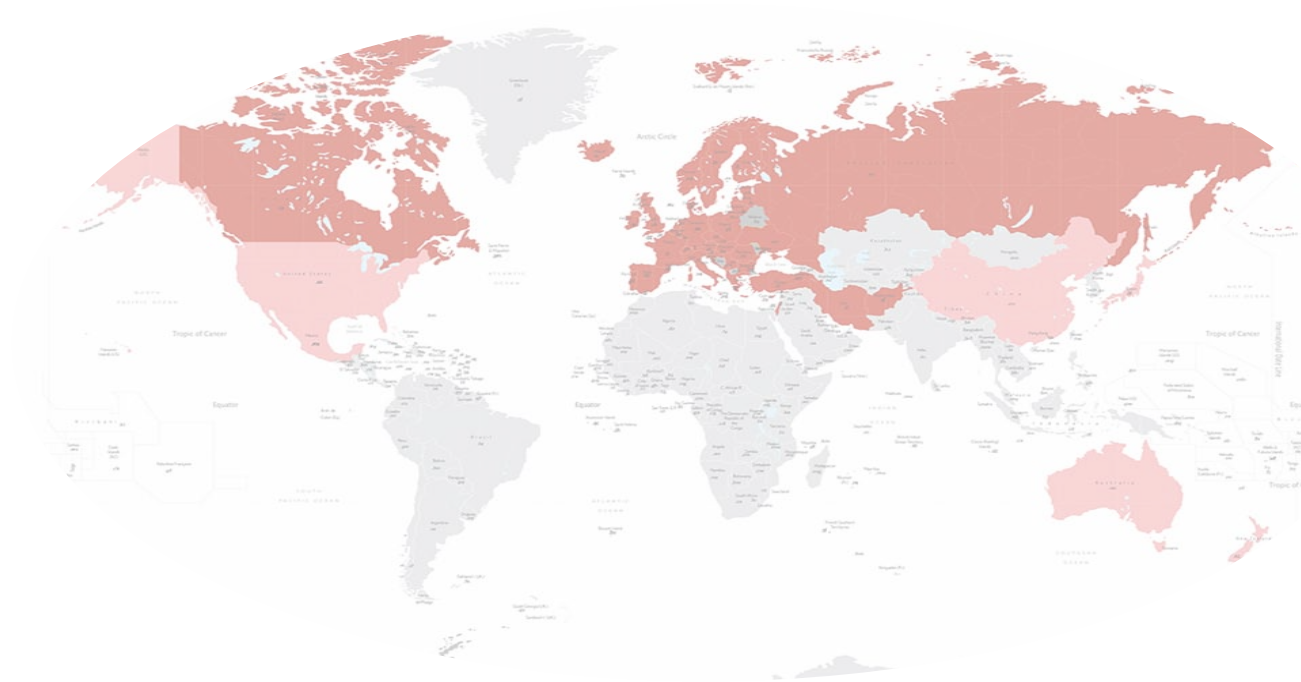

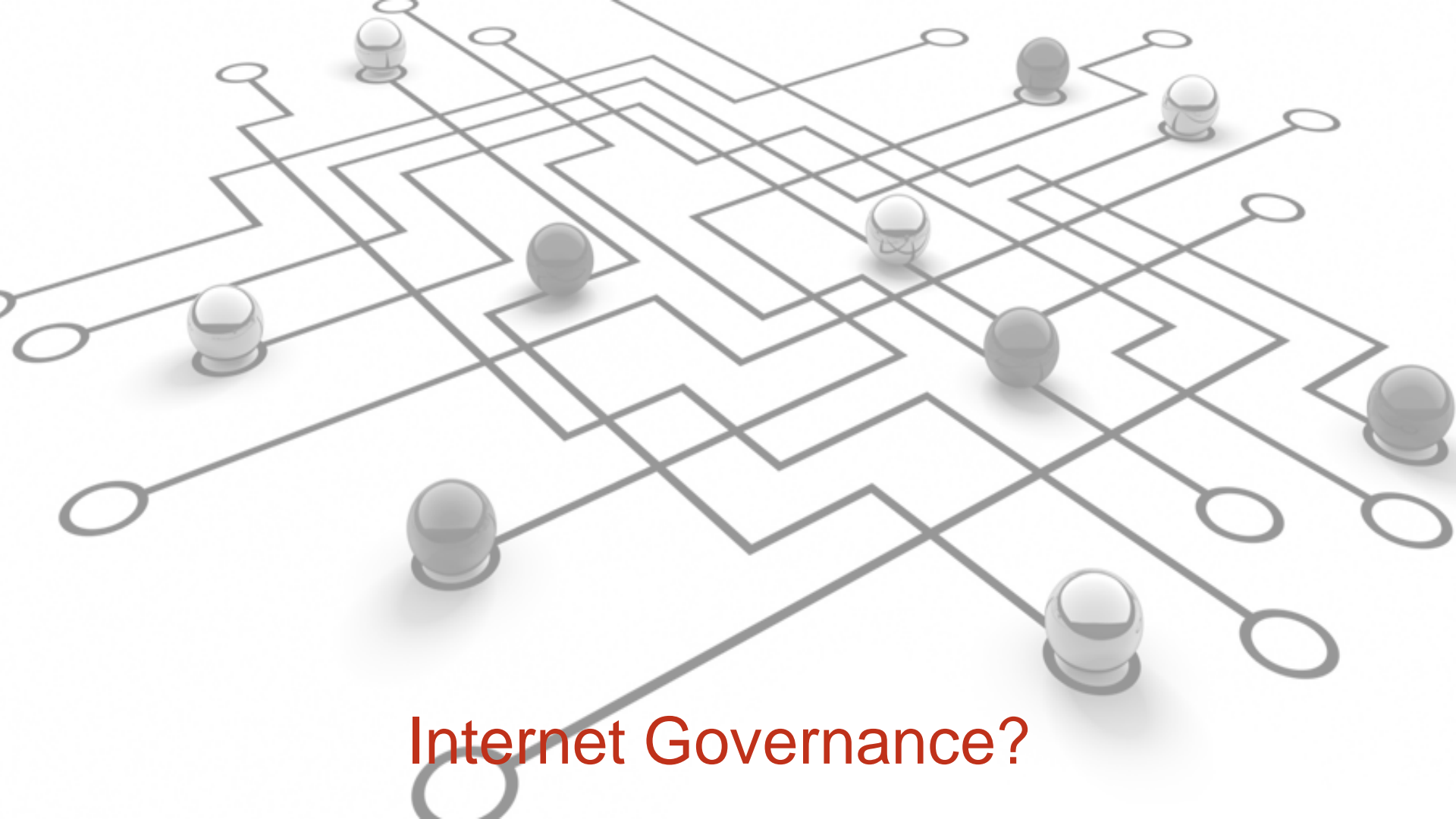

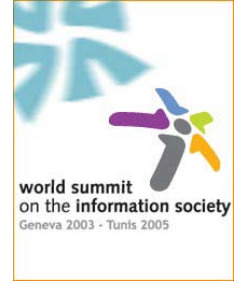

Multi-stakeholder participation : *UN bodies, international organisations, NGOs, civil society, private sector*

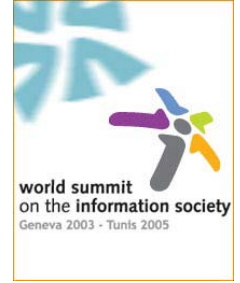


General Principles for Internet Governance

Par 29 Tunis agenda:

The international management of the Internet should be **multilateral, transparent** and **democratic**, with the full involvement of governments, the private sector, civil society and international organizations

Multilateral - Transparent - Democratic - Multi-stakeholder



Enhanced cooperation

“... to enable governments, on an equal footing to carry out their roles and responsibilities, in **international public policy issues** pertaining to the Internet, but **not in the day-to-day technical and operational matters**, that do not impact on international public policy issues”
