

Rainforest <u>as a whole</u> is not manageable, it can neither be governed, nor controlled





General Principles for Internet Governance

Par 29 Tunis agenda:

The international management of the Internet should be multilateral, transparent and democratic, with the full involvement of governments, the private sector, civil society and international organizations

Multilateral - Transparent - Democratic - Multi-stakeholder



Enhanced cooperation

"... to enable governments, on an equal footing to carry out their roles and responsibilities, in international public policy issues pertaining to the Internet, but not in the day-to-day technical and operational matters, that do not impact on international public policy issues"


